


PROGRESS REPORT



As the year 2022 draws to a close, our club and community are buzzing with activity. Everywhere you look, houses are covering the mountains and our empty lots are filling in! It won't be long before the only construction area will be the MacDonald Mountain area, and even that area has houses starting to proliferate. It's exciting to see our extraordinary community move toward its completion.

Not only are the houses filling in the community, DragonRidge Country Club is poised for even more exciting development. The year 2022 saw the completion of the club's new resort-style swimming pool and also the newest party venue, The Palm Court. The new year will see even more development as renovations to the main clubhouse and the fitness center move toward completion.

Our plan is to build in phases. In the main clubhouse, the Montrose dining room will be the first room to be renovated. The fitness center will also soon have new flooring throughout, including in the exercise room. 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
MEET THE AARON'S

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Media headlines are focused on a crashing U.S. real estate market, but the truth is more nuanced with less hyperbole.

Context matters: The reality is that the market is down, but simple comparisons to a sky-high 2021 are amplifying the scale of the decline.

While existing home sales are down in the second half of 2022, the deviation from historical averages is not nearly as extreme as the drop from last year.

The pandemic housing boom pushed home prices. The current market conditions are moving toward stability. Las Vegas home values are still historically high for sellers. For buyers, the market is moving; more properties are becoming available, and sellers are lowering their prices.

The most recent report from the Las Vegas Realtors revealed that local home values fell for the sixth consecutive month in November 2022. This is a trend that is undoubtedly being felt in Southern Nevada

However, the median home price is still up 2.6% from a year ago. Consider that local home prices are nearly four times higher than they were in January 2012, when they reached their post-recession low.

There is currently a 4.8-month supply of houses available in Southern Nevada, which is a massive increase of 463.2% from the prior year. Months of supply are a good indicator of whether a particular real estate market is favoring buyers or sellers. Typically, a market that favors sellers has less than 6 months of supply, while more than 6 months of supply indicates an excess of homes for sale that favors buyers.

According to Nevada Census data, there will be a 1.51% increase in population between 2020 and 2025, as well

as a 1.46 percent increase in median income during the same period. Even though builders are bringing more homes to market, demand continues to outpace supply. Builders are still not building at a rate that meets the needs of homebuyers.

All these factors will lead to less supply and will help keep the single-family home values from crashing in Southern Nevada. The Las Vegas metro area home values are predicted to rise between 1 to 2 percent (or may remain flat) over the next twelve months.

Las Vegas LUXURY Real Estate Market

In November 2022, 63 homes sold for \$1 million or more, compared to October's 97 homes, a decrease of 34 homes. The median sales price in the Luxury Market decreased to \$1,350,000 and in October that number was \$1,530,000. Last year's price surge cannot be sustained amid the high mortgage rates which dampened the housing demand due to buyer pull pack.




"and that seems to be different than how most of the Strip world operates. He says whatever you need, let's make it happen."
