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


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

I want to thank so many of you who have expressed your well wishes to me as I've begun the slow recovery process from surgery. Good news is we caught it in time – no active cancer!

As most of you can see, the majority of our renovation plans are complete except for the Dragon Grille. The plan for this is to move the family dining to either the fitness café or The Palm Court, while we begin construction. We're moving ahead to purchase all that we need for this job now so we can move through this project as quickly as possible.

The golf course is also moving along quickly. Our contractors have completed their work and our staff has started the overseed process at which they excel. HOA LETTER

A MESSAGE FROM THE MANAGEMENT:

With the holidays quickly approaching, we know many residents will be hosting parties and get-togethers within the community. We would like to help make entry for your guests as quick and easy as possible! The Association has a state-of-the-art guest management software system at the main entry gates, called QuickPass, which all residents can and should utilize whenever possible. Residents have the ability to log-in to this system and add guests for their upcoming events and parties. Entering these lists early ensures that your guests will have minimal interruption when entering the community. In the past, we have had residents turn in handwritten quest lists right before a gathering, and this leads to confusion as gate attendants try to cross reference the list, and at times they are unable to make out the names of the guests. Using the QuickPass system to enter your guest list eliminates this tedious process and allows the gate attendants to more easily confirm your guests and allow them to pass.

To access your QuickPass account, visit www.quickpass.us. Once on the website, enter your username and password. If you do not know your username or password, please contact the management office via email or phone, and we can provide this information to you. Once in the system, you can either go to "Visitors" or "My Events" and enter your

information. This system can be used for planned parties and gatherings, or your day to day visitors. You would enter day to day visitors (guests and vendors) under the "Visitors" tab, and persons attending a party or gathering under the "My Events" tab. You can enter guests as either temporary visitors, duration visitors or permanent visitors, and you pick the length of time temporary and duration visitors will be granted access. Permanent visitors will remain on your guest list until you remove them, and they will be granted access without needing to be approved each time they arrive. As well, you can also remove guests and vendors from your account through the system at any time. If you need assistance navigating the system, or have any questions, please feel free to contact either myself, or my assistant Julie Murray, and we will gladly assist you.

If you have a smart phone, you can also download the QuickPass app and add your guests remotely wherever you are, without having to contact the gate house or management office, and the information immediately transmits to the gate houses. We would also like to inform you that if you do not have a smart phone or computer access, or simply are not comfortable with using the QuickPass system, you can still provide a guest list (typed preferred, or legibly written) to either of the guard shacks





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or management at least 48 hours in advance of your gathering, and we can have the names input in the system on your behalf. If your gathering requires additional gate house staff, or additional roving services due to the $\frac{H}{R}$ cost for the extra staff will be passed on to you.

With the holiday season also comes concerns with residents and their guests and parking. Listed below are several of the parking Rules that are routinely violated during the holiday season, and we ask that you please advise all guests of said Rules:

- Due to City of Henderson Fire Code, on-street parking is limited to one side of the street only. Approved street parking for visitors or guests will be limited to the sidewalk side of the street. If there is not a sidewalk on that street, parking will be limited to the South or East side of the street only.
- Visitors and guests must have a pass displayed and visible in the vehicle window at all times.
- All vehicles parked within the community must have current registration and insurance.

MARKET REPORT

Luxury Market in The Beginning of Summer

June 2023 recorded 114 homes sold for \$1 million and above, marking a decrease of 18 homes from May's 132. This shift suggests a potential shift in high-end buyer preferences. The median sales price for the luxury market experienced a \$20,000 decrease, dropping from \$1,515,000 in May to \$1,495,000 in June.

Luxury Market by The End of Summer

Overall, there were 152 sales of \$1 million and higher in August 2023, overtaking the previous 2023 high of 137 in July. The 152 sales tops the 118 in August 2022 and is the most since 156 closings in June 2022. The previous Las Vegas record for August closings was 122 in 2021. The average closing price in August was \$2.02 million, a slight increase over the \$1.93 million in July. It was \$1.7 million in August 2022 as luxury closings slowed with the rest of the housing market as mortgage rates started to rise.

Is the Luxury Market Still Hot?

Much like our desert climate and booming tourism industry, the Las Vegas real estate market has been one of the hottest in the country. The U.S. Census Bureau ranked the Las Vegas metro area as the 97th fastest-growing. In the past decade, Las Vegas' population has exploded, increasing by nearly 20% to about 2.8 million people today. 2023 is averaging a 2.11% growth rate. However, that is down from 2.42% growth in 2022 and 2.70% growth in 2021.

This market's seller-friendly housing trend has become more of a buyer's market in 2023, with home sales showing signs of weakening. I also think it is because the luxury home prices have kept increasing. There's no doubt that the Las Vegas real estate market is rebalancing. This also means buyers and seller both need to re-balance.

Simultaneously, the city is one of the 10 most popular migration destinations. While selling a house in our market is becoming more challenging, people remain interested in moving to Las Vegas, especially from California as we see in MacDonald Highlands often.

Where are the Luxury Buyers and Sellers?

Unfortunately for buyers, there's not enough luxury inventory of luxury homes in our market. Luxury homeowners who purchased before the pandemic are likely to have low interest rates which seems to be outweighing their home equity and decision to sell. Unfortunately for sellers, there's not as many luxury buyers in our market as well. Like most local real estate markets, Las Vegas is shifting from a seller's market to a neutral environment that possibly has the potential please buyers and sellers if both sides can be reasonable rather than aspirational.

Luxury Build a Home vs. Buy a Home

If you can believe it, MacDonald Highlands now has only 27 developer lots remaining and left to sell.

The cost to build is decreasing, build material is available and we are not seeing supply chain issues.

One of our preferred lenders has just announced new Construction Lending products to Loan off of Appraised value versus lending off Cost-to-Build. This is Phoenominal! I haven't seen this before so it presents a real opportunity for you to build.

This will greatly reduce the cost of out-of-pocket expense to build. Less than 10% out-of-pocket in many cases. Ironically, construction loan interest rates haven't gone up like mortgage interest rates. Construction Loan rates

have remained and are still in the 6's. Mortgages to buy home requires 20-30% Out-of-Pocket for conventional 80/20 or 70/30 Loan to Value Mortgages.

Net Net building is very attractive and should be considered in Fall 2023!

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A Destination Travel CHRISTMAS MARKETS

It is hard to believe that it is almost Christmas again. Where did the year go?

One of the things I have wanted to do for several years is go to the Christmas markets in Europe. Well, this is finally the year! Rich and I, and our daughters Nicole and Paige, are going for an Avalon Waterways River cruise. This trip will take us from Vienna to Budapest, and we will be traveling to various Christmas markets along the river.

We will start with a few days in Vienna. We have been to Vienna before but only on our way to another destination. This year, we want to see the city. As with other towns in Europe, the Christmas decorations are beautiful. In addition to the Christmas market, we want to see the iconic Vienna Opera House and St. Stephen's Cathedral, as well as the Schonbrunn Imperial Palace complex (the winter residence of the Imperial Family).

Stephansdom Platz (commonly called St Stephans) is open to the public and you can stroll on in. Walk up Kohlmarkt, and just down the road you will reach the Spanish Riding School with the Lipizzanner horses. The Hofburg Palace is an absolute MUST just to behold the facade!

Schonbrunn Palace takes about half a day to see. Tickets can be prepurchased with your travel agent or bought there. Get the 'classic tour' ticket as it covers the Gloriette and the maze in the gardens, along with extra rooms in the palace you wouldn't get with a standard ticket.

If you double back toward the Hofburg again and keep going, you'll reach the Opera House. If you have a free night, go to a performance by the Hofburg Orchestra... tickets can be bought 1 day in advance, within the archway to the Spanish Riding School.

The Spanish Riding School is home to the Lipizzanner horses. There are tours of the stables and also a show. There are mixed reviews, but horse lovers really enjoy it.

Vienna is known for their Sachertorte chocolate cake. The classic Sachertorte is a chocolate cake, denser than your usual sponge cake, with one or more layers of jam (usually apricot) and covered with chocolate glazing. The result can be described quite simply as delicious.

After two or three days in Vienna, you would sail to Krems, a small valley town seemingly untouched by the modern world. During lunch, you would sail through the



picturesque Wachau Valley to Melk. In Melk, in addition to the Christmas Market, you will take a tour of the Benedictine Abbey with its frescoed ceilings, ornate pipe oraan and library.


Overnight you will sail to Bratislava, Slovania, where you will enjoy the Gothic halls of St. Martin's cathedral church, and spend time browsing the stalls of the Christmas Market. Later that day you will set sail for Budapest.

Budapest is a beautiful city. It is known for its cafes and pubs, as well as their unique Christmas market. The most beautiful, oldest and internationally acclaimed Budapest Christmas fair is the Christmas Market on Vorosmarty Square in the heart of the city (since 1998). They also have the Santa Claus Train which runs in early December. Santa Claus has a special day, Dec 6(St Nikolaus's day), while the Christmas presents in Hungary are brought by the Baby Jesus (or the Little Angel).

In the United States, I love Roger's Gardens in Corona Del Mar, CA. It is a beautiful place to visit anytime you are in the area. From November 10th to December 23rd, they are a great source for Halloween and Christmas items. It is an entertaining place to just walk around, even if you are not buying anything.

Locally, I always go to Ralph Jones Display on Charleston Avenue when I want to get into the Christmas mood. Ralph Jones Display maintains one of the largest year-round inventories of Christmas stock, specializing in oversized Christmas trees and wreaths as well as animated characters. Their beautifully decoraed trees range from 2 to 25 feet in height and a variety of styles. They also carry a complete assortment of decorator colors and styles in bows, ribbons, garlands, ornaments and other trimmings. They can design, fabricate, install, and take down their seasonal exhibits for you. They have been decorating hotels and casinos for years.



Bandon Dunes **GOLF RESORT**

On July 27th, a group of DragonRidge members and I headed to Bandon Dunes Golf Resort for a few days of golf and fun. For those of you who may be unfamiliar, Bandon Dunes is golfing mecca on the coast of central Oregon nestled between the towns of Bandon and Coos Bay. Developed by Mike Keiser and his company Dream Golf, the Bandon Dunes course, which was the first of the five courses, opened in 1999. The renowned Pacific Dunes opened in 2001, with Bandon Trails, Old MacDonald, and Sheep Ranch to follow. The property boasts four golf courses in the Golf Digest America's Greatest 100 courses and one in America's Second Greatest 100 courses.

Travel to the resort can be done by flying into Coos Bay (a 30-minute drive to the resort) via SFO or by flying into Eugene (a 2.5-hour drive to the resort). The resort offers its own lodging and dining options. Due to the exceptionally high demand for visits to the property, it is anticipated that scheduling a trip to Bandon Dunes will not be possible until well into 2025. Our group stayed at the Bandon Manor, a property located a half mile away from the resort. The Bandon Manor offers four master bedrooms, a large great

room with individual soft seating for eight, a large dining table, a pool table, a ping pong table, and a hot tub in the backyard. A Golden Knights flag proudly flew off the house as we arrived at the property.

Bandon Dunes is undoubtedly known for epic golf and stunning views, but the unpredictable weather has also made a name for itself. The golf gods were looking down on us that week when we caught what our local caddies described as "Ban-Diego" weather. Our trip ended with a fun two-person scramble contest on the 13-hole Preserve short course. I highly recommend carving out some time to play the Preserve one afternoon or morning.

We returned to Las Vegas after five days with great memories and an appreciation for the vision that Mike Keiser and his team had for the property. If you love golf and have not been to Bandon Dunes, this trip is an absolute must.





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
